



Lesson 5: Exploring the Lamby Locality

Learning Objective:

- Identify geographical patterns within context of land use.
- Identify processes contributing to development in the area.

Introduction:

As whole class look carefully at a map showing the Lamby Way site and its surrounding area (See **TEACHER RESOURCES- MAP**). Discuss the development around the site. Consider the following points:

- Residential development
- Commercial development
- Industrial development

Main Activity:

Show children photos of local wildlife (see **TEACHER RESOURCES- GALLERY**). Focus on the following pictures:

- Hawks
- Horses
- Rats
- Fish

Whole class discussion about the living conditions these animals experience at Lamby Way. Focus on the following issues:

- Accessibility to food
- Shelter
- Predators
- Pollution/ safety
- Human interference

Lower Juniors: Choose an animal to write about whether or not they would choose to make Lamby Way their home.

Upper Juniors: Divide class into four groups, one representing each animal. Have a mini group discussion about pros's and con's of living at Lamby Way. Individually write about their animals lifestyle using a 'Day in the life of.....' format.

Plenary: Share their writing.
